

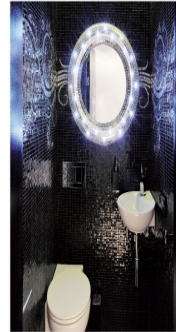
# Living in Style: Architecture Interiors

The book introduces the reader to the ideas behind the designs. They describe the client's specific demands or problematic questions that arose during the project development, although some of the spotlight texts also focus on one specific design aspect. The text and clear pictures help to explain the individual concept ideas behind the designs. The rooms talked about in the book are unique and often feature customized and tailor-made solutions, although that doesn't mean that many of them can't be used as inspiration for new or different designs.

The division of the rooms is often imaginative. For example, a living room separated from the dining area with an acoustic shell, or contrasting materials can be used to define different zones. Translators from one room to the next can be reflected by connecting surfaces, or similar colors – posing that anyone can live in style.
